

Waitākiri BYOD Information

Our Programme (Years 4–6) Our BYOD programme ensures students benefit from digital learning in creative and collaborative ways. By using **Jamf School** (Mobile Device Management), we provide a secure, teacher-monitored environment during school hours while leaving the device in your control at home.

1. Device Requirements

To ensure compatibility with school apps and iOS updates, please meet these criteria:

- **Suitable Models:** iPad Air (3rd Gen+), iPad 7th Gen+, iPad Pro 11", or iPad Pro 12.9" (3rd Gen+).
 - **Incompatible: iPad Minis** are not suitable for school use.
 - **Storage:** 64GB is sufficient for school use.
 - **Protection:** A **robust iPad case** is mandatory.
 - **Optional:** Apple Pencil and external keyboards.

2. Setup & Enrolment Process

- **Backup:** iPads are **reset** during setup. Save important photos/files to the cloud first.
 - **Sign Out:** Sign out of personal Apple IDs in *General Settings* and **disable the Passcode**.
 - **Agreement:** Read, discuss, and co-sign the *Digital Use and BYOD Agreement*.
 - **Enrolment Day:** Bring the device to school on our enrolment day at the start of the year for initial setup.

3. How Management Works (Jamf School)

Jamf is a management tool, not a surveillance product. It allows the school to apply profiles and policies to ensure focus during learning.

- **School Hours:** The Jamf profile connects the device to School WiFi, provides school apps free of charge, and enforces **Safe Search** and internet filtering.
 - **After Hours:** On weekends, holidays, and after school, these restrictions **automatically lifted**. The device remains under parental control.
 - **Home Use:** You can sign into your own Apple ID in the App Store to download personal apps or books. Use **Apple Family Sharing** to manage your child's screen time at home.

4. Important Notes

- **Charging:** iPads must be brought to school **fully charged** every day.
 - **Privacy:** Use caution when signing into a personal Apple ID at home, as it may sync your personal photos, contacts, and browsing history to the student's device.
 - **Participation:** We aim for a 1:1 ratio in Years 5/6. If BYOD numbers are low, we may be forced to return to a shared-device model.
